IDENTIFICATION

BIRTH CERTIFICATE

- Birth Certificate can be requested online through a vital records request
- There is a fee for the search and record
- Tip: Request more than one copy as additional copies are cheaper
- Will need a form of ID to upload when making the request
- If incarcerated, a face sheet from jail and court paperwork with your name on it may be acceptable
- **Chippewa County:** If you are a Chippewa County resident, you can ask Criminal Justice Services to assist you with this process.
- You can get a birth certificate from any County in Wisconsin at any Register of Deed's Office.

- If you **do not have** one of these documents, you will be asked to show other documents such as:
 - Employee identification card
 - School Identification card
 - Health insurance card
 - U.S military identification card

- Bring documents and the completed application with you to your Social Security office

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Marketplace Health Insurance (Affordable Care Act)

Health insurance for those that do not qualify for Medicare, or Medicaid or receive insurance through work.
