A credit report is a statement that has information about your credit activity and current credit situation such as loan paying history and the status of your credit accounts.

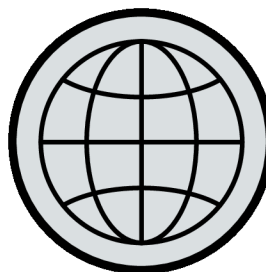
Free weekly online credit reports are available from Equifax, Experian and TransUnion. Regularly check your credit history at www.annualcreditreport.com



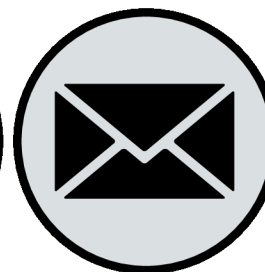
CREDIT REPORT BASICS

- Information needed to get credit report: your full, legal name, Social Security Number (or ITIN via mail), date of birth, current residence and previous addresses for past 2 years.
- Review the report for accuracy. If errors are found, you can dispute it with that specific credit bureau.
- Requesting your own credit report does not hurt your credit score.
