

TAX WITHHOLDING

Tax withholding is the amount of federal & state income tax withheld from your paychecks and paid to the government through the year.

- Withholding too much tax will result in a tax refund.
- Withholding too little tax will result in a tax bill.
- You can change your withholding by updating a W-4 form through your payroll or HR dept.

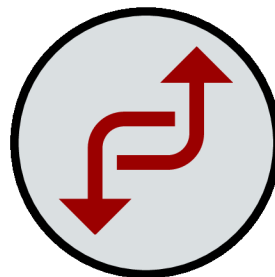

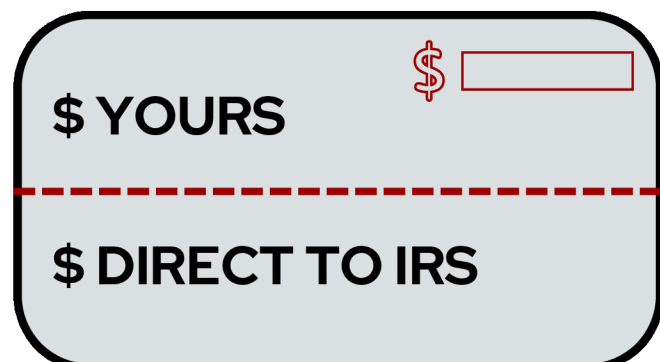
